

PEER REVIEW POLICY

All the papers of the Journal *Influence of Scientific Applied Research on the Quality of Modern Studies* undergo a double - blind peer review process to maintain standards of research quality and credibility in accordance to the following procedure:

Initial review. The Editor-in-Chief evaluates each manuscript to determine if its topic and content is within the scope of the Journal concept and meets the minimum Journal requirements and criteria: for reference, see **Journal ISARQMS Paper Guidelines**. Manuscripts that do not meet minimum criteria are returned to the authors.

Peer review. The Journal employs the double-blind peer review process, where both reviewers and authors remain anonymous throughout the review process. The Editor-in-Chief selects two Editorial Board reviewers based on their expertise in the field. The author's name and credentials are removed prior to the forwarding of a manuscript to a Reviewer in order to promote objectivity and ensure that a manuscript is fairly judged based on its content and contribution to the field. The review is made in accordance to the Journal **ISARQMS Paper Guidelines**.

Paper acceptance. After collecting and assessing the reviews, the Editor-in-Chief makes a final decision on the acceptability of the manuscript and informs the authors about the decision by email. If the Reviewers indicate that the manuscript needs revisions and alterations, the Editor-in-Chief informs the author accordingly and jointly decide on the period of the next re-submission.
